The following information is provided to ensure a smooth transition from check-in through course completion.

3. **LOCATION.** Cheatham Annex, Williamsburg, Virginia. The base is located about two miles from I-64 on Route 199 (East) between Yorktown and Williamsburg.

4. **DIRECTIONS**

- a. FROM INTERSTATE 64 East or West: Take exit 242B onto Route 199E, which turns into SR-641. Go approximately 2 miles to the front gate. Once on base, keep going straight approximately 1/3 mile to Bldg. 250 on right. Park in lot just past Bldg. 250.
- b. FROM NORFOLK INTL AIRPORT (ORF): Take I-64 (West) through the Hampton Roads Bridge Tunnel. Take exit 242B onto Route 199 East. Go approximately 2 miles to the front gate. Once on base, keep going straight approximately 1/3 mile to Bldg. 250 on right. Park in the lot just past Bldg. 250. This is an approximately one hour trip.
 - C. FROM NEWPORT NEWS / WILLIAMSBURG INTL AIRPORT (PHF):

Exit the airport left onto 143 East (Jefferson Ave). Go one mile to I-64 West. Take I-64 (West) to exit 242B onto Route 199 East, which turns into SR-641. Go approximately 2 miles to the front gate. Once on base, keep going straight approximately 1/3 mile to Bldg. 250 on right. Park in lot the just past Bldg. 250. This is an approximately 20-minute trip.

d. FROM RICHMOND AIRPORT (RIC): Exit the airport onto South Airport Drive. Go three miles to I-64 East. Take I-64 (East) to exit 242B onto Route 199 East, which turns into SR-641. Go approximately 2 miles to the front gate. Once on base, keep going straight approximately 1/3 mile to Bldg. 250 on right. Park in lot the just past Bldg. 250. This is an approximately one hour trip.

5. **SECURITY GATE REQUIREMENTS**.

- a. For Force Protection Conditions (FPCON) ALPHA through CHARLIE: Members traveling in a Personally Owned Vehicle (POV) must have a current Military ID to be admitted through the gate. It is important to note that Taxis and ride services such as Uber and Lyft are not allowed on base.
- b. For Force Protection Condition DELTA: Access to the base will be limited to essential personnel only. Cheatham Annex will follow all Naval Weapons Station Yorktown FPCON instructions. For any issues, NAVELSG CDO can be contacted at 757-592-0398.

- c. **DIRECTIONS TO PASS & ID FROM CHEATHAM ANNEX:** From the gate, go straight passing Water Country USA and Days Inn, and take exit to I-64 East. From 64 East, get off on exit 247. Make a left at the off ramp stop sign and Gate 3 will be located on the left. If you have questions for the Pass & ID office their phone number is 757-887-7338.
- 6. <u>CHECK-IN</u>. All personnel will check in at 0730 in **Building 250** on the Drill Deck on the first day of class. (Arrive 15 min early)
 - a. Bring all necessary documents to include:
 - Original Approved Orders and any modifications (no DRAFT versions)
 - Valid Military ID Card
 - Any required licenses, completed HRT screening forms, or medical cards for driving classes per CANTRAC prerequisites.
 - b. Missing documents WILL delay the processing of your orders for pay.
- c. Please consult with your NOSC Medical department if medical/dental records are needed.

7. ORDERS AND PAY

- a. When working your orders in NROWS, ensure the additional comments block reads: "No return flights authorized before 1600 on the last day of the orders."
- b. AT/ADT-School orders will be collected for processing on the first day of the AT period. Orders will be processed by PSD Little Creek. Bring at least two copies of your orders. IDTT orders will be collected and endorsed at check-in and will be returned to members at the completion of the IDTT period.
- c. All funds for pay, allowances and travel are issued by direct deposit. Checks are no longer issued. It is advisable to bring direct deposit information (account, bank routing numbers, voided check) if you have not previously been reimbursed for travel by direct deposit. Ensure that you have your Government Travel Credit Card (GTCC) with you and that it has been activated by your unit or NOSC prior to starting your travel. If you do not have a GTCC make sure you have an alternative means to cover lodging and travel expenses.

8. BERTHING.

- a. Government Berthing is available but limited. The "Colonies" are operated by Navy Gateway Inns and Suites and are located on $4^{\rm th}$ St at Cheatham Annex. For reservations, please call Cheatham Colonies at 757-887-7712.
- b. There are several area hotels close to Cheatham Annex. Prior to checking in at a commercial hotel you must obtain a "Certificate of Non-Availability" (CNA) from the check-in desk at the Cheatham Colonies. Failure to do so could significantly impact the amount you are reimbursed for lodging costs. A CNA number on your itinerary will not suffice.
- 9. <u>MESSING</u>. Government Messing is not available and you will be receiving per diem. The only dining facility on base is the 4th Street Grille located

across from the gym. The 4th Street Grille is the most convenient place to eat during classes. Their hours of operations are:

MON-FRI: 0630-1330 (Breakfast 0630-1000, Lunch 1100-1330) **SAT-SUN and Holidays: CLOSED**

10. <u>TRANSPORTATION</u>. Transportation is the responsibility of the member. Commercial transportation is not generally available from hotels and personnel are encouraged to request rental vehicle authorization. To avoid a costly error, ensure orders authorize a rental vehicle in writing before signing the rental contract.

11. UNIFORMS

- a. The working uniform is as follows: Navy Working Uniform Type 3 Khaki E-7 and Above (Optional)
- b. See NAVPERS 15665I for specific direction on current Navy uniform wear policies.
- c. ***IMPORTANT: Personnel attending courses are required to bring the following:

HARD HATS
STEEL-TOED BOOTS
LEATHER GLOVES
FOUL WEATHER / COLD WEATHER UNIFORM ITEMS AS NECESSARY

NOTE: PERSONNEL WITHOUT STEEL-TOED BOOTS WILL BE DROPPED FROM THE COURSE REQUIRING THEM TO BE WORN.

12. <u>CIVILIAN CLOTHES AND SEASONAL TEMPERATURE</u>. Appropriate civilian attire is authorized after school hours. Seasonal temperatures vary greatly. The summers are normally hot and humid with temperatures in the 90's. Thunderstorms are very common. Winters are windy and cold with average temperatures in the mid 30's with occasional snow.
